IMPACT OF MENTAL ILLNESS

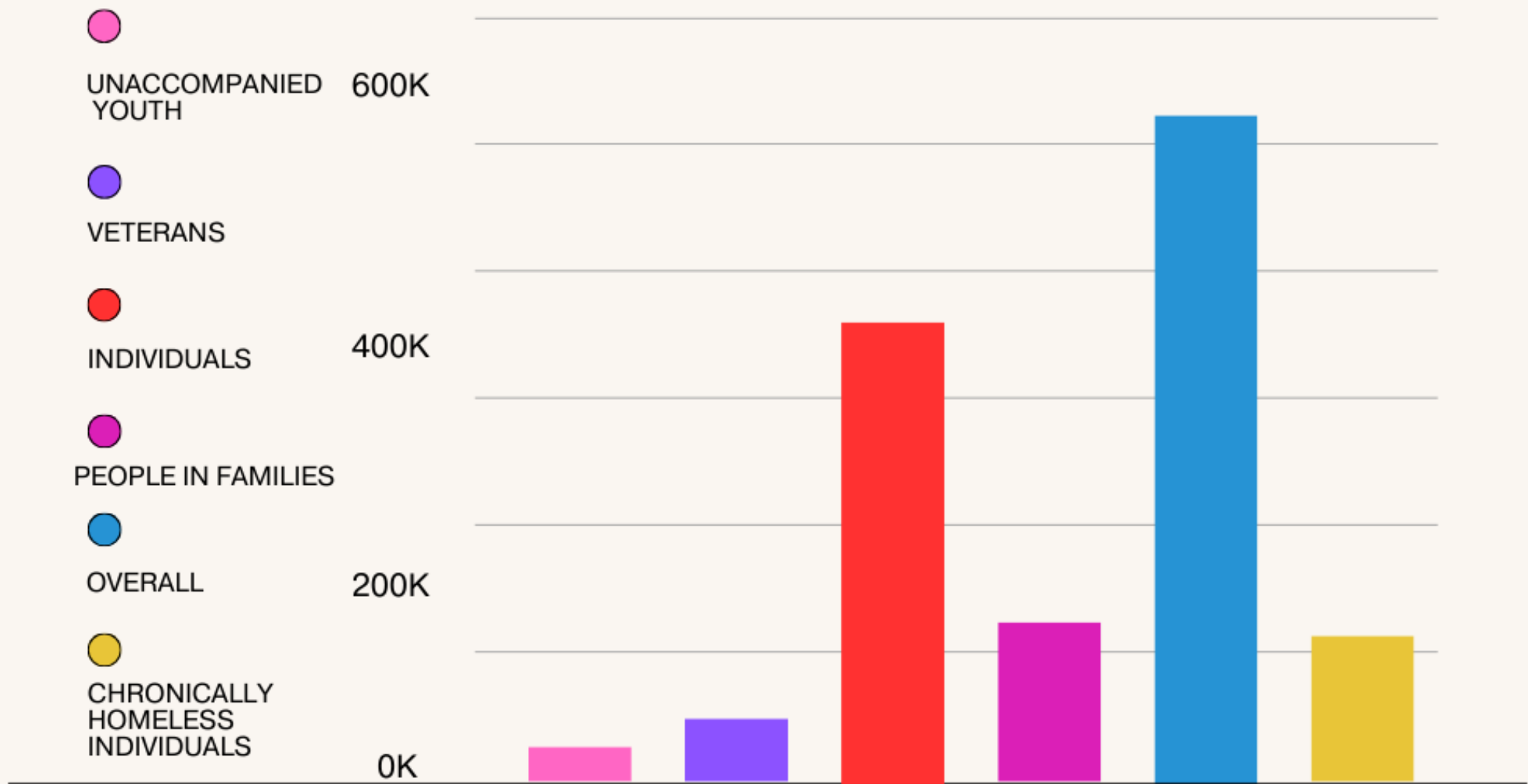
Not many people know that those living on the streets often come from abusive families or have suffered neglectful and traumatizing experiences as a child, that led to serious mental illness, such as major depression, bipolar disorders, schizophrenia, psychosis and issues with drugs and alcohol abuse that are likely to be both the cause and consequence of their condition and a high risk of death.
